Harbour Grand Kowloon

POSITIONED ON THE MAINLAND ACROSS FROM HONG KONG is the magnificent Harbour Grand Kowloon. The views of Hong Kong from the property are incomparable and the hotel itself offers facilities like a rooftop pool, a grand staircase often used for weddings, and a shopping area frequented by Chinese citizens and offering goods at almost half the price as you'll find in Hong Kong.

The hotel is easy to get to, close to the airport, and the facilities and fare are as good as any hotel in Hong Kong.

The rebranded Harbour Grand Kowloon was formerly named Harbour Plaza Hong Kong and is a deluxe five-star hotel with 554 beautifully appointed rooms including 86 suites and serviced suites located along the Kowloon waterfront and offering breathtaking views of Victoria Harbour.

The hotel is adjacent to the ferry pier traveling to North Point and is only five minutes away by complimentary hotel shuttle bus to MTR Hung Hom Station and downtown Tsim Sha Tsui's business and shopping district. The property's key facilities include wireless broadband Internet service available throughout the hotel; a deluxe fitness center with sauna, steam bath, and spa services; a rooftop pool featuring a one-sided glass wall overlooking the harbor; six renowned restaurants; a 4,500-square-foot Grand Ballroom; and four versatile function rooms for meetings and conferences. ●
