REGENT (REGENTHOTELS.COM) WAS FOUNDED IN THE '70S AND BECAME the first truly Asian-based global hospitality group. In the '80s and '90s, Regent properties, such as the Regent Hong Kong and Regent Beverly Wilshire, were among some of the world's most acclaimed hotels. In 1992, eight Regent hotels were recognized by Condé Nast Traveler as among the Top 25 Hotels in the World, with more than half of the best 14 hotels on earth carrying the Regent name. The brand was later sold to Four Seasons and then Carlson before finally being acquired by FIH Regent Group. The existing Regents are located in Beijing, Berlin, Porto Montenegro, Taipei, and Singapore. Regent Chongqing is set to open in the fourth quarter of 2016, Regent Place Harbin in 2017, and Regent Jakarta, Indonesia in 2018 respectively. In 2011, all hotels in the Regent-managed portfolio were listed as the best luxury hotels in the world by the Condé Nast Traveler's Readers' Choice Awards, becoming the first and only international luxury hotel group to ever achieve this recognition. In 2013, the group was fifth in the worldwide ranking of the World Luxury Index measuring the most searched and sought-after luxury hotels.
