

The New York Palace



MANAGED BY THE DORCHESTER COLLECTION, The New York Palace (www.newyorkpalace.com) offers visitors the finest in old-world elegance and new-world opulence with 805 rooms and 88 suites to choose from. Conveniently situated in the heart of Manhattan, the hotel's world-renowned courtyard has served as the entranceway to the historic Villard Mansion since 1882. Today, The New York Palace Hotel couples the Villard Mansion with a contemporary 55-story high-rise that was completed in 1980. The Towers is a "hotel within a hotel," featuring 176 graciously appointed guest rooms and suites and a private club offered solely to guests of the Towers. Diners will appreciate the celebrated GILT restaurant, a Michelin two-star fine-dining establishment.



The Towers boasts exquisitely furnished rooms and suites designed in both contemporary and traditional décor, all featuring spacious, fully appointed marble bathrooms, with King-bedded and Double rooms measuring in excess of 400 square feet, Junior Suites more than 600 square feet, and one- and two-bedroom Corner Suites exceeding 1,170 and 1,570 square feet.



One option for guests seeking the best the property has to offer is a stay in the 4,000-square-foot Royal Suite, which reflects the grandeur of the classic French culture and style of Kings Louis XV and XVI. A large Italian and French marble foyer welcomes guests to this palatial three-bedroom residential-style suite, the hotel's grandest, with his and her bathrooms in the master bedroom. A full-size kitchen with breakfast nook makes for easy entertaining as does the formal dining room with seating for 12 that adjoins the double-size living room with elegant French doors.



Guests looking for a more unique experience may book one of four signature Triplex Suites, each with 5,000 square feet spread over three floors, decorated in contemporary Art Deco style and boasting 19-foot floor-to-ceiling windows offering exceptional skyline views. Visitors to the three-bedroom, six-bathroom penthouses enjoy exclusive privileges, including a wood-burning fireplace, a fully equipped kitchen, a 10-seat dining room, and a private elevator for the suite's three floors. Guests will also enjoy access to the expansive 1,500-square-foot private rooftop terrace complete with outdoor furniture, a bathroom, pantry, and wet bar. ●
