## *The Setai Fifth Avenue*



THE SETAI FIFTH AVENUE (SETAIFIFTHAVENUE.COM), A CAPELLA managed hotel opened in November, offers around-the-clock services distinctive to Capella Hotels & Resorts. Designed by architects Gwathmey Siegel & Associates, the property soars more than 60 stories above Manhattan's Fifth Avenue and offers 157 guest rooms and suites and 57 apartment suites, including three penthouses, all of which are among the largest accommodations in the city. Condominium residences are also available for sale, from the 28th to the 60th floor.

Exceptional dining options for guests include the property's signature restaurant, Ai Fiori, which blends traditional Italian fare with a modern perspective and offers a five-star menu that is tough to compete with.

Visitors looking to grab a drink will enjoy Bar on Fifth for their signature cocktails or exclusive house-made ginger beer in a plush sanctuary of luxurious couches and cushioned club chairs. World-renowned jazz pianist and composer Antonio Ciacca was recently appointed Artist-in-Residence and will present his trio and quartet, and curate concerts featuring some of New York's finest jazz musicians every weeknight as part of Jazz at Setai.

The latest offering at The Setai Fifth Avenue includes an interactive children's Sunday brunch. Launched this past August by Bar on Fifth, "Tunes with Tina" is a weekend brunch with Princeton-educated singer, songwriter, and jazz pianist Tina De Varon, where kids and parents are invited to sing along while indulging in a prix-fixe menu in a fun but upscale setting. At just \$40 per person and \$20 for kids three and under, weekly performances are Saturdays and Sundays at 10 AM with a second seating planned for later this fall. ●
