Omni Berkshire Place New York

OMNI BERKSHIRE PLACE (OMNIHOTELS.COM/NEW-YORK-berkshire) is located between 5th Avenue and Madison Avenue near Rockefeller Center, Radio City Music Hall, Central Park, and Times Square. Guest rooms and suites were designed with the feel of an Upper East Side residential townhome, while keeping them spacious and larger than most Manhattan accommodations. The property boasts 398 luxury guest rooms including 44 suites; a 17th-floor sundeck overlooking St. Patrick's Cathedral; 24-hour in-room dining; a state-of-the-art fitness center; 7,000 square feet of function space; and a 24-hour business center.

No well-heeled traveler will want to forego the experience of staying in one of Omni Berkshire Place's incredible suites. The ultimate New York townhome, where the musical *Oklahoma!* was written in 1942, Omni's Rodgers and Hammerstein Suite features a 500-square-foot wraparound terrace boasting skyline views with elegant furniture, dining room, living room, one and a half baths, and a spacious master bedroom. Located on the penthouse floor with sweeping views of Manhattan, the space is 1,000 square feet and sleeps up to four adults and is also great for private events.

The Madison Suites, of which there are 17 one-bedroom corner units, offer 781 square feet of comfortable space and are great for meetings. Separate living areas overlook 52nd Street and Madison Avenue, with fantastic views.

The 5th Avenue Suites, of which there are six, vary from 450 to 500 square feet and are great for the leisure traveler. Offering city views that can include St. Patrick's Cathedral or Fifth Avenue and several featuring balconies or terraces, the units are located on floors 14 and above and have separate living rooms, sleep up to four adults, and can accommodate a rollaway bed. ●
